

AP WORLD HISTORY FOUNDATIONS TIMELINE PROJECT

Purpose: In AP World History we are driven by five major themes. This project forces each student group to focus on these themes and how that particular theme they chose to research was comparable to other regions in the world how that theme changed over time.

Process: In each class students will be divided into 4 person teams and each team will be assigned a specific . Students will have a period of time to research.

Rubric:

1. Organization, neatness, clarity
2. 10 pieces of evidence, in chronological order, with their appropriate date.
3. At least one piece of evidence per theme must come from the following four regions (South Asia, Middle East/North Africa, East Asia, Western Europe). Regions must be identified.
4. Visual images (must be a primary source)
 - a. Artwork, architecture, or photograph-
5. Comparison or contrast must be in the form of claim, data, commentary. You will need two pieces of data.
